Here are the new regulations set forth by the WEC in accordance with the governor's proclamation last week.

WEC Spectator Guidelines (Updated 12/17/20)

Governor Reynolds modified her proclamation with new guidelines on Dec 16, 2020. Below is a list of the changes made.

New guidance states that member schools will be allowing two spectators per participant unless all of the spectators are from the same household. **This means that for each participant, one of two options are available:**

1. All members of the household may attend the game.
2. Two members from outside the household may attend the game.

Schools will allow one of these options, **but not both.**

Tonight at HLP the gym will be cleared out after each contest. You will need to reenter past the admittance gate if you are allowed to stay for a later contest. Please do not arrive more than 15 minutes prior to the game you are watching. You will not be able to enter.

Masks are required! Please do your best to wear your masks correctly and at all times. Also, remind your children that masks are required for them as well.

The first game of 2021 will be a home game against Sibley Ocheydan, on Monday, Jan 4, 2021. There will be a JV Boys game beginning at 4:45.
